2020 Colorado Oil and Gas Commission Mission Change Rulemaking, the 900 series regulations, Environmental Impact Prevention, adopted a new rule 903.d.(4). Please see new rule below:

903.d. (4) Operators will notify all mineral Owners of the volume of oil and gas that is Vented, Flared, or used on-lease. Operators will maintain records of such notice and provide the records to the Director upon request.

The Commission adopted a new Rule 903.d.(4).B requiring operators to expand reporting requirements about tl1e volume of natural gas vented, flared, or used on lease to include mineral owners, rather than solely being reported to the Commission on a Form 7 pursuant to prior Rule 912.c. The Commission adopted this Rule to provide an additional incentive for operators to avoid waste and capture natural gas and for beneficial use.

The directions below will allow you to search your well information and determine how much natural gas has been vented, flared, or used on-lease, if any.

How to Access your Well Information:

- 1. Go to COGCC website, https://cogcc.statc.co.us/
- 2. The green bar at the top of the screen has multiple links. Click on the "data" link.
- 3. Once the "data" page has been accessed, click on the "production" link. This page will allow user to perform production data inquiry.
- 4. Search well information by:
 - a. Well API The first two digits of API number, 05, are not used for the search. County Code should be a three-digit number, Sequence Code Should be a five-digit number.
 - b. Well Name
- 5. Click on the specific year for review
- 6. The Well Production Data will be displayed. The "gas used" column identifies the used on-lease gas that is specified in 903.d.(4).
